


Connecting MyRacePass to Race Manager


A window will appear. If you have never downloaded MRP Live click the Download Application button to download MRP Live.




Run the installer and follow the prompts.




Once the application has been installed click the Launch from Web button to start up MRP Live. After the very first time installing the MRP Live application you will not have to do it again in the future.





When the MRP Live application is run for the first time you will see the screen below. Select Westhold Race Manager as the timing software.

Set the Assignments Path to C:\RaceManager\Assign\ by clicking the Browse button and locating the Race Manager Assign folder. If Race Manager is a fresh installation you will have to create the Assign folder. See further down for instructions on creating the Assign folder.




Click Confirm when done.

Creating Assign folder with Race Manager if Race Manager has never been installed.


Go to Race Manager's Assign page. Then click the Add New button.




A window will pop up after clicking Add New. Type in something under New Assignment and click OK. This process generates the Assign folder that MRP Live will use.



Once the assignment has been created you can select and delete it.



After clicking the Confirm button in MRP Live. If Enable Network under Race Manager's RMonitor section is not checked you will get an error message. This can also occur if the IP address and port number used are incorrect. See further down about IP address and port number settings.




By default MRPLive will attempt to use the computer's IP address. You will see that in the Race Data section. In this case it is 192.168.1.246. However, be aware that many computers have more than one network interface (wired and wireless). MRPLive pulls up the first one it finds.

This means there can be more than one IP address. This can cause connection issues between MRPLive and Race Manager if MRPLive attempts to connect through the wrong address/network interface.

We suggest you change the IP address to **127.0.0.1**

127.0.0.1 is a special purpose address and is called the localhost or loopback address. All computers use this address. This allows MRPLive app to bypass the network interface hardware so there is no guessing which IP address is the correct one to use.

By default the port number is 50000. This number must match what is in Race Manager's RMonitor section.



